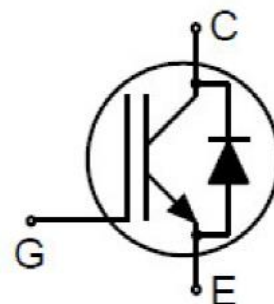

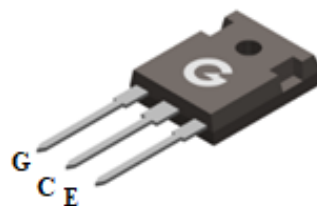

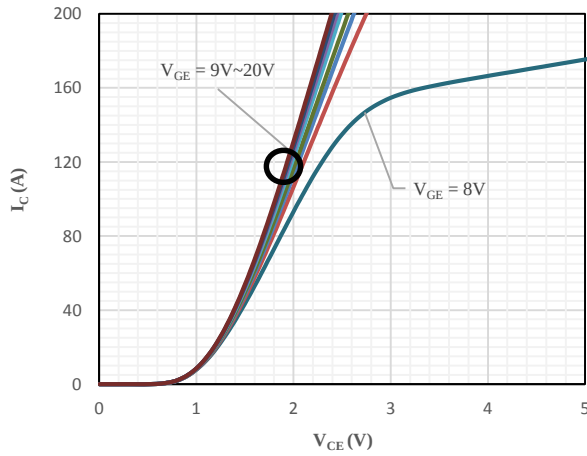


Fig 1 Typical Output Characteristics

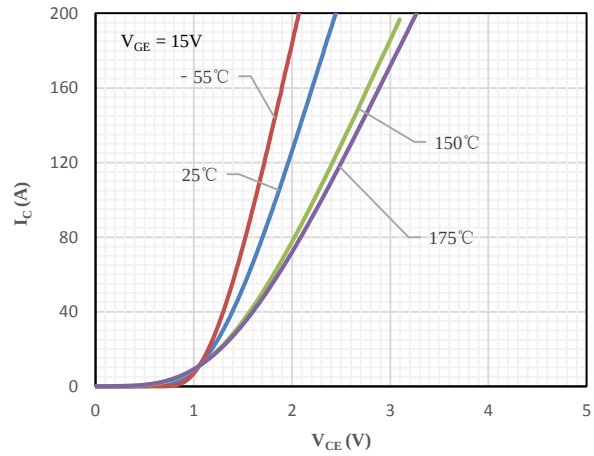


Fig 2 Saturation Voltage Characteristics

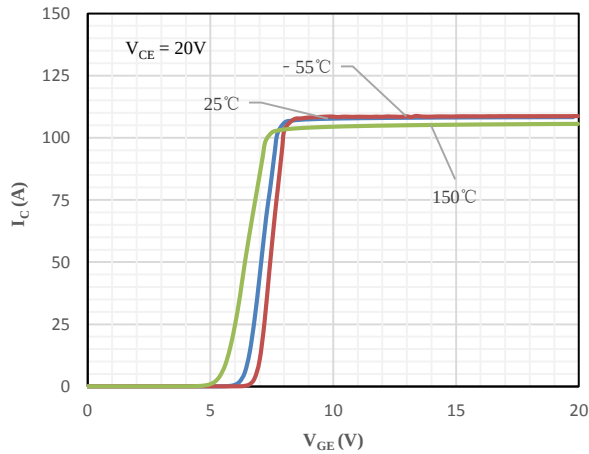


Fig 3 Transfer Characteristics

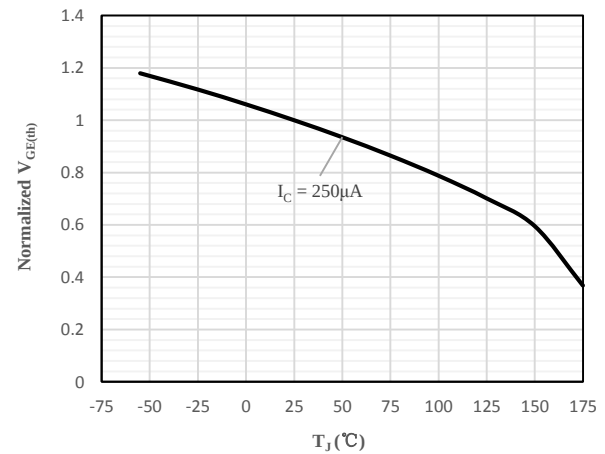


Fig 4 Normalized $V_{GE(th)}$ vs. Junction Temperature

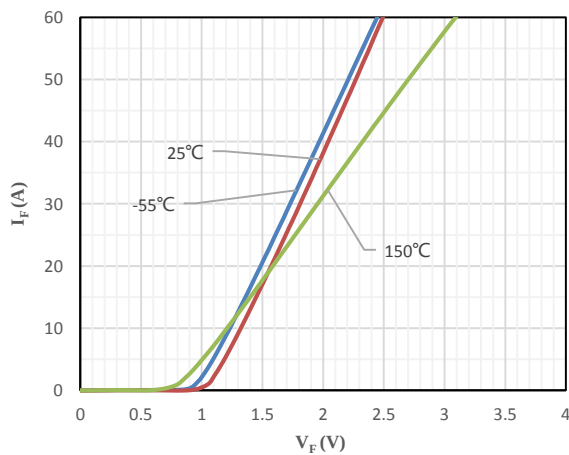


Fig 5 Diode forward current as a function of forward voltage V_F vs. I_F

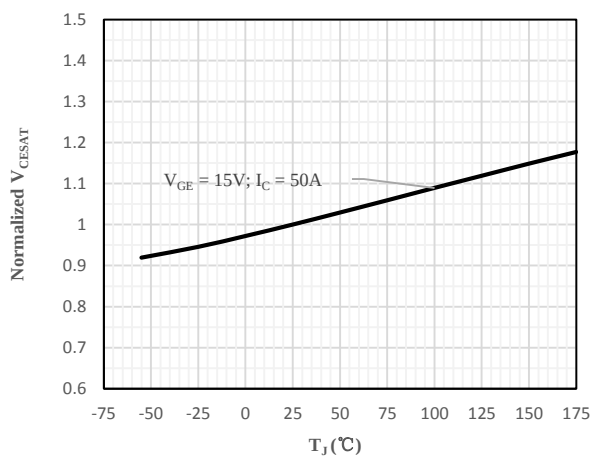


Fig 6 Normalized Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Junction Temperature

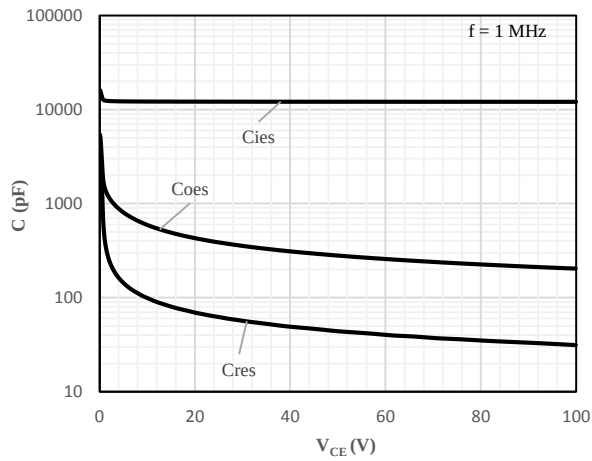


Fig 7 Capacitance Characteristics

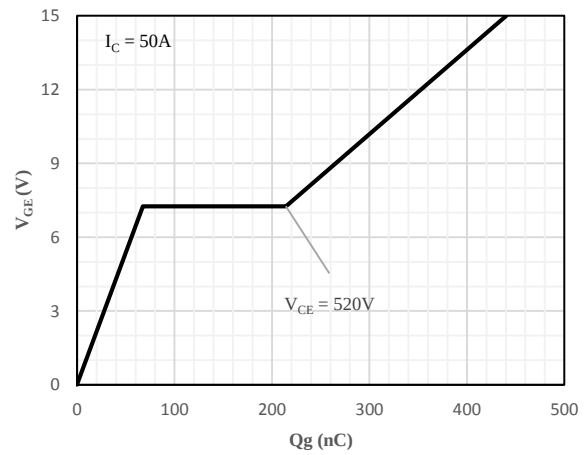


Fig 8 Gate-Charge Characteristics

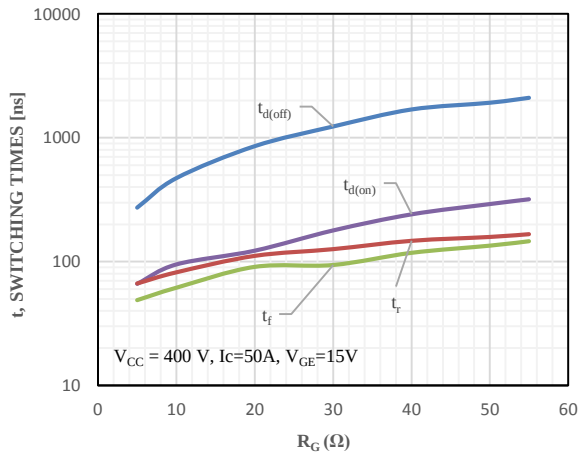


Fig 9 Switching Times vs. Gate Resistor

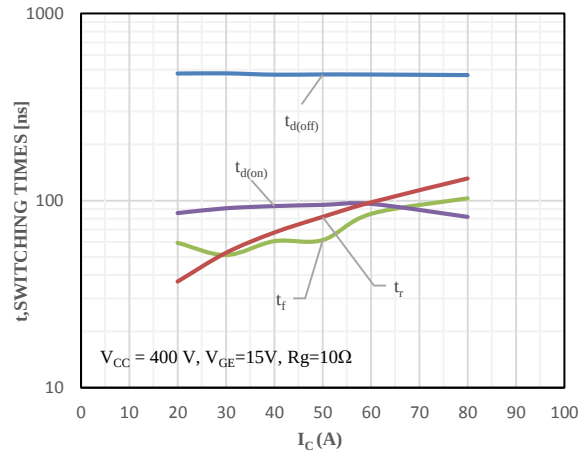


Fig 10 Switching Times vs. Collector Current

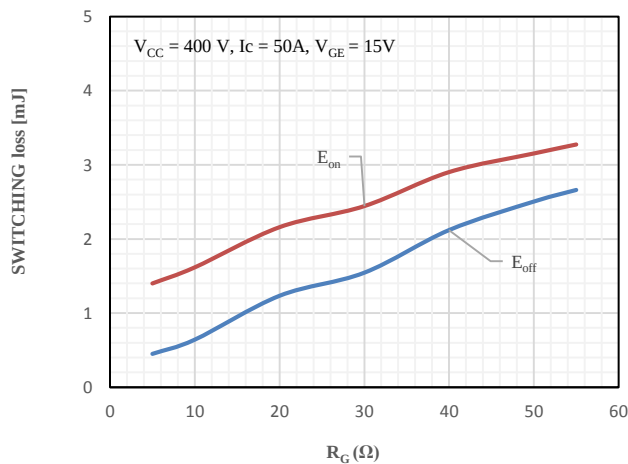


Fig 11 Switching Loss vs. Gate Resistor

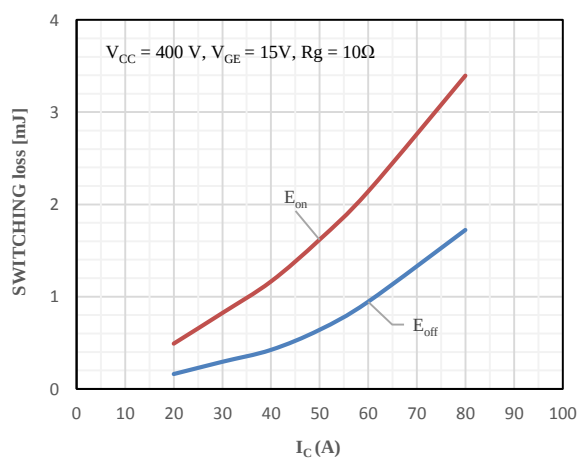


Fig 12 Switching Loss vs. Collector Current

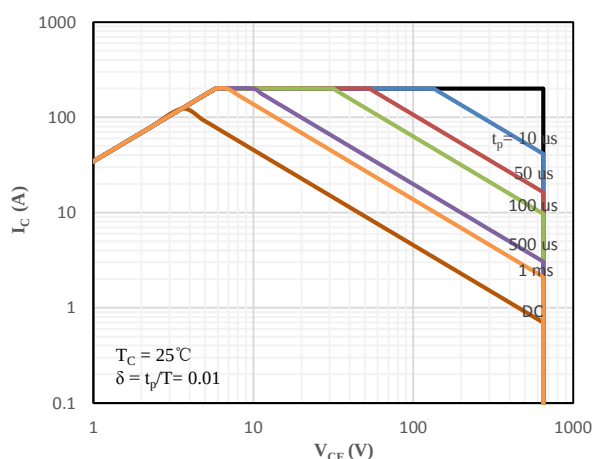


Fig 13 SOA characteristics

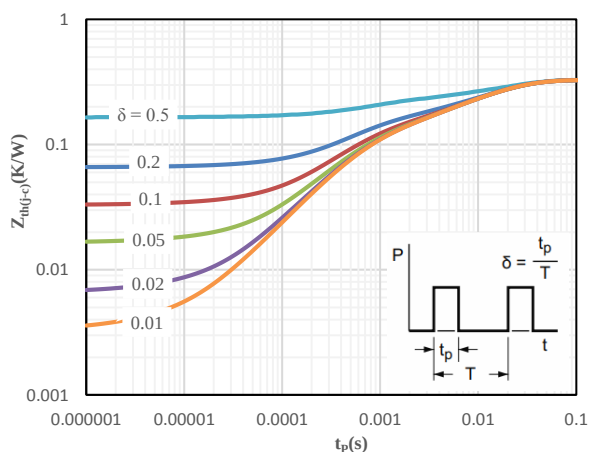
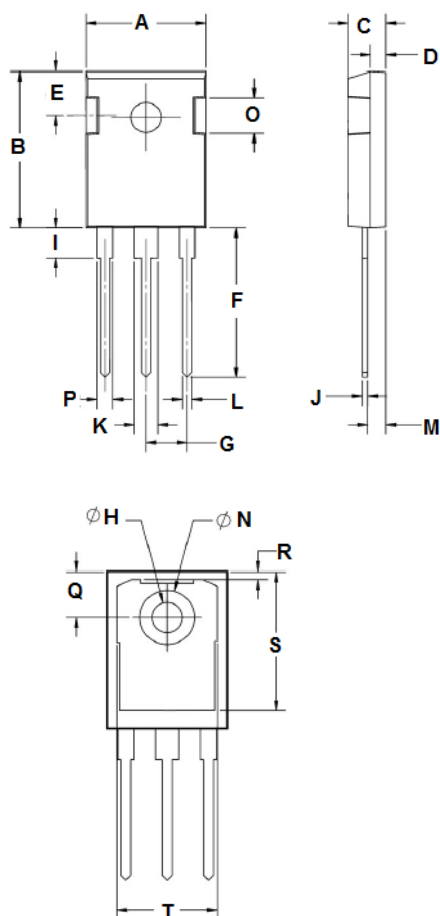


Fig 14 Maximum transient thermal impedance
